## Software Engineers

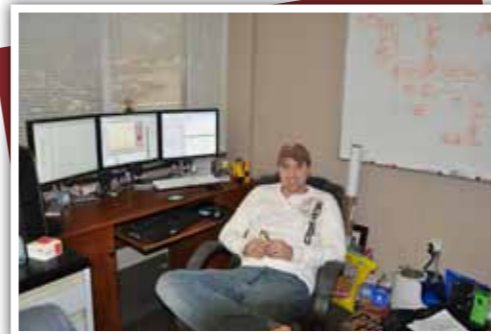
### Joe Billman
